**TOURNAMENT RE-SEEDING FOR PLACEMENT BRACKETS D, E, AND F:** After the completion of the first two playoff games; all teams will be reseeded into final tournament placement brackets D (1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup>), E (4<sup>th</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup>), and F (7<sup>th</sup> – 9<sup>th</sup>). The winners of Brackets A, B, and C will move into bracket D. The second place finishers for Brackets A, B, and C will move into bracket E. The third place finishers for Brackets A, B, and C will move into Bracket F. In the rare event that a three way tie occurs within a bracket, the teams will be reseeded in the final placement brackets based on their initial seeding level in the tournament. Hence, the highest seed will move on to bracket D, the second highest seed will move on to bracket E and the lowest seed in the bracket will move on to bracket F.

**SFL FINAL STANDINGS POINT SYSTEM:** The league champion and final team placement standings are based on a point system. Each team earns one point per win for the match play games (8 points possible) Each team earns the following points for their placement in the SFL Championship tournament: 1<sup>st</sup> place = 8 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> place = 7 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> place = 6 points, 4<sup>th</sup> place = 5 points, 5<sup>th</sup> place = 4 points, 6<sup>th</sup> place = 3 points, 7<sup>th</sup> place = 2 point, 8<sup>th</sup> place = 1 point, 9<sup>th</sup> place = 0 points. The team(s) with the greatest combined points from the first round and tournament will earn the league championship. All teams with the same combined points will share the final standings placement Co-Champions or multiple teams tied for third place are possible.

**CIF SAC-JOQUIN SECTION QUALIFYERS AND SEEDING:** The top four teams from the SFL final standings will earn a birth to the CIF-Sac-Joaquin Division II Section Playoffs. In the event of a tie for seeding, the tie-breaker will be the head to head winner in the SFL tournament. If the teams in question did not meet in the tournament, the tie-breaker will be the head to head winner from their regular season match. The final tie-breaker for multi-team ties (if the head to head tie-breaker does not resolve the seeding) will be a coin flip.
